

Camp Scholarship Benevolence Guidelines
Updated 2.20.10

SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW TEAM POLICIES AND GUIDELINES:

1. A family meeting one or more of the following financial needs will be considered for a Full or Partial Camp Scholarship:
 - a medical condition or crisis which has placed the family under financial constraints
 - a loss of household income within the immediate family
 - single parent household
 - households with 3 or more children of camp age
2. Additional extenuating financial conditions will be evaluated by the review team on an individual basis.
3. In addition to the Camp Scholarship Application, each child who receives a scholarship (full, or partial) will be encouraged to complete 10 hours of service at Lifepath by August of the same year the scholarship is awarded. (a list of service opportunities will be published by the Director of Children's Ministry at the time the scholarship is awarded.)

PROCEDURES:

1. The Camp Scholarship Application must be completed in full and submitted by the camp scholarship application deadline noted on the application and as advertised by the Church.
2. All applications will be reviewed by the Director and Elder of Children's Ministry, the Financial Controller and the Finance and Administration Elder.
3. The Financial Controller will notify eligible families of scholarship amount awarded.
4. The Financial Controller will submit payment directly to the specified camp as noted on the Camp Scholarship Application.
5. A list of service opportunities will be published for the scholarship recipients by the Director of Children's Ministry at the time the scholarship is awarded.
